Food Hygiene Congratulations to our cooks and the School Lunch Company for maintaining their five star Food Hygiene Certificate. The kitchen regularly prepares 750 meals a week for The Hendreds and Grove CE Primary School.

School Lunches The cost of school lunches for children in Classes 3, 4 and 5 is £2.20 per day. The total cost for next half term is £66.00. Payment can be made via the Tucasi system which is updated daily. If you think you may be entitled to free school meals, please ask at the school office in confidence if you would like us to check your eligibility.

Ford Castle For parents of children in Years 4 and 5, if you haven't already done so, please complete the permission slip on Tucasi. If you are paying by instalments, the second instalment of £26 is now due, and, if you haven't already paid it, the deposit and first instalment are now overdue.
