**Key Stage 2 Carol Concert Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2025 5:45pm**

We are writing to inform you about the exciting preparations that the children are undertaking for this year's KS2 (classes 3, 4 and 5) Carol Concert. As many of you know, we have proudly staged a Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols in our Sports Hall for many years, incorporating a range of traditional readings and carols which enable our children to sing in several languages and showcase their quality as a choir. We will need all the members of the choir to participate, so please let your child's class teacher know as soon as possible if there is any reason why your child may not be able to attend.

Two adults or older siblings per family can attend the concert. As usual, we ask that no younger siblings attend. We will not be issuing physical tickets, so we ask for your honesty to ensure that we have sufficient capacity for all families in the hall.

Children should leave school as normal on Wednesday and come back to school promptly at 5.30pm in their costumes. If your child is attending after school club that day, they will need to bring their costumes to school in the morning. Children should be dropped off at the main office entrance at 5:30pm and parents can then make their way to the main sports hall. We expect the concert will last around 45 minutes. If you cannot attend, please collect your child/children from the main sports hall entrance after the concert.

Costumes are traditional Victorian/Dickensian. We are eager to maintain our tradition of simplicity in costumes – we anticipate that all children can use or borrow items that they have at home so there is no need for you to order or buy any special costume for the event.
